

## Seminoles Golf Team In 4th Spot

LAKE PLACID - Florida State's golf team takes a fourth place 900 total into today's final round of the Placid Lake Invitational here.

Florida leads the tournament on the par 72, 6,900 yard course with an 874 after 54 holes. Georgia Southern and Jacksonville are tied for second at 892.

The remaining scores have Florida Atlantic at fifth with a 912, then Tennessee 915, South Florida 918, Rollins 927 and St. Leon 963.

Florida State's Ray Thompson, who was third among individual shooters going into yesterday's round, finished with an 81 and dropped to No. 6. Thompson has a 227 total.

Other Seminole scores are Jim Ihnot at 227, Steve Mullins 228, John Ruby 230 and Johnny Godwin 279.

Andy Bean of Florida is leading with a 215 after managing a 69 yesterday. Florida has two others in among the top four shooters.

Today's final round will be 18 holes.

## Seminoles 3rd in Golf

LAKE PLACID — Florida State's golf team finished third behind Florida and Georgia Southern in the Placid Lake Invitational here yesterday.

The Seminoles ended with a 1,192 for 72 holes. Florida had a 1,149 and Georgia Southern 1,184. Jacksonville was fourth at 1,195.

Andy Bean of Florida was the medalist shooting a 68 in the final round for a 285 total.

Ray Thompson and Steve Mullen of Florida State tied for eighth among the individual shooters at 300. Mullen had a 72 and Thompson a 73 yesterday.
