Florida State Golfers Place 4th at Tulane

NEW ORLEANS—Playing in their fourth tournament of the fall, Florida State's golf team wrapped up fourth place in the Tulane Golf Invitational Friday at Lakewood Country Club as Seminole Frank Zayatz tied for fourth in the individual count at 228.

As a team Florida State shot a 932 over the 54 - hole, three day event, finishing 15 strokes off Houston Baptist's winning pace. Nosing in front of the Seminoles were LSU - NO at 925 and Memphis State at 930.

John Lewis of the winning team also captured the medalist trophy by coming from two

strokes off the pace to win with a 222, six over par. Zayatz battled Memphis's David Hallford to the fourth place deadlock, bettered by LSU's Shelby Houston's 223 and Baptist's Robert Slegman's 225.

Figuring in the Seminole linksters' scoring were Bob Impaglia with 231, Kim Heisler, 239, Todd Crandall, 242, Steve Mullen, 243, and Doug Fischesser, 234.

Trialing the top four teams were LSU, one stroke behind the Seminoles at 933, host Tulane, 937, Southwestern Louisiana, 939, South Alabama, 973, and Centenary, 1039.
