

FSU Golfers Top Gators For Title

Host Florida State captured the Seminole Invitational golf tournament Sunday, finishing four strokes ahead of defending National Collegiate Athletic Association champion Florida.

Florida State's five man team finished with 872 strokes as Todd Crandall led the way with an even par 216 total for 54 holes on the par 72 Seminole Golf Course. Teammates John Godwin and Doug Fischesser each had 219.

Medalist honors went to Buddy Alexander of Georgia Southern, who had three-under-par 213. Alexander finished with a round of 66 Sunday.

Runnerup to Alexander was Andy Bean of Florida with a 214, including a 74 Sunday.
