

## Wake Forest Cops Crown

PINE MOUNTAIN, Ga. (AP)

— Sophomore Curtis Strange has led Wake Forest, the national college golf champion, to its fourth straight All-Dixie Intercollegiate Golf tournament crown.

Strange took individual honors with a three - day 206, 10 strokes below par.

The Deacons surged ahead 15 strokes in Monday's final round to overpower Georgia and Florida with a team total of 863. Georgia finished with 878 and Florida with 883.

Florida's Phil Hancock had set the record in the first round Saturday.

In team play, Georgia Southern was fourth at 892, North Carolina State fifth at 893, and East Tennessee State at 896.

Other team scores included: South Carolina 899, Auburn 903, Clemson 905, Alabama 906, Memphis State 908, North Carolina 915, Florida State 920, Furman 923, Kentucky 932, Florida International 933, Florida Southern 935, Columbus College 937, Troy State 937, Rollins 948, Georgia Tech 957, and the University of Tennessee at Martin, 961.
