FSU golfers place fifth

GAINESVILLE — Florida State finished fifth and Seminole freshman Grant Turner wound up third in the Gator Invitational golf tournament that ended Sunday with Georgia dominating the 15-school event.

Turner had started the day deadlocked with Georgia's Griff Moody for the individual lead, but took two shots to get out of a bunker on No. 18 Sunday for a double bogey. Kenny Knox of the Seminoles finished 13th with a 219. Other FSU scores included a 226 by Steve Bys, a 227 by Jim Crowley and a 237 by Marcus Beck.

FSU tallied an 886 team score, jumping past Auburn and South Florida on the final day for fifth place.

UF finished second with an 878, followed by Georgia Southern at 879 and LSU at 884.
