## **FSU golfers lead Dixie tourney**

After two rounds of the Dixie Intercollegiate golf tournament, the Florida State men's golf team leads the 32-team field with a total of eleven-under-par 565.

The Seminoles shot an eight-under 280 Saturday and lead second-place Florida by seven strokes. Auburn is in third at 577 and Georgia dropped from first after the first round to sixth at 583.

For FSU, Mike Grant is in third after shooting a two-under 70. He has a total of 139 which is five-under par. Grant Turner is at 69-142, Paul Azinger has a 70-142, Stephen Keppler a 74-145 and Paul Downes came home at 71-145. Final round play starts this morning.

## **FSU golfers lose by a stroke**

COLUMBUS GA. — The FSU men's golf team, competing without one of its top players on the back nine, lost the Dixie Intercollegiate Tournament Sunday by one stroke to Florida.

FSU's Paul Downes started out the back nine at even-par but a recurring hand injury acted up and was forced to withdraw. The Gators took the title with a three-round total of 857.

For the Seminoles, Mike Grant took fourth at 71-210 and Paul Azinger came home sixth at 71-213. Stephen Kepler and Grant Turner tied at 219 as Kepler had a 74 Sunday and Turner shot a 77.
