COLUMBUS, Ga. — The Florida State men's golf team is in first place after one round of the 26-team Dixie Intercollegiate tournament at the Bull Creek golf course.

FSU's Greg Fleischer is in third place individually after shooting a three-under-par 69, and teammate Keith Kulzer is tied for fifth with a 70.

Auburn's Carter Mize leads the tournament with a five-under-par 67, followed by Columbus College's Mike Walton, who sho a 68.

The tournament ends Sunday.
