FSU golfers in sixth

MONTERREY, Mexico — Oklahoma State University golfers posted a 11-under-par 565 after two rounds Friday to lead the Pan American University International Intercollegiate Tournament.

Texas and Texas A&M are tied for second with 566 totals.

Florida State shot a team-total of 583 Friday, and is sixth, along with

Houston Baptist.

The final 18 holes of the three-day tourney will be played today. Eighteen teams including four from Mexico are represented in the competition at Club Campestre de Monterrey.

Stan Utley of Missouri and Brandel Chamblee of Texas shared individual honors after shooting identical scores of 65 and 69 for a two-round total of 134.

FSU was led by Stephen Keppler and Brian Kamm, who shot 144s and are tied for seventh. Other FSU golfers include Greg Fleischer (147), Jon-

athan Morrow (149) and Keith Kulzer (151).

FSU men golfers finish sixth

MONTERREY, Mex. — Florida State's men's golf team finished in sixth place, with an 871 team-total, Saturday after the final round of the Pan American University International Intercollegiate tournament.

Texas won the three-day event with a team score of 853. Oklahoma State finished a shot back for second place, and Brigham Young came in third with a total of 867.
