ATHENS, Ga. — The Florida State

men's golf team is in first place after the first round of the 26-team Southern Intercollegiate Championship.

The Seminoles finished with a team score of 289 (1 over par) while Oklahoma State was in second at 289. Texas A&M (290), Tennessee (291), Clemson (293) Florida (294) and Wake Forest (295) follow.

Florida State's individual scores were: John Morrow — 68; Greg Flescher — 70; Keith Kulzer — 75; Brian Kamm — 76 and Greg Garde — 77.
