

## FSU golfers share second in state event

SEBRING — The Florida State University men's golf team is tied for second place after Friday's second round in the State Championship at Sun and Lakes Country Club.

Rollins is in first place in the 15-team tournament with a score of 593. FSU and Miami are next at 606 and Central Florida is in fourth place with a 609. Florida Southern is fifth at 614.

Three golfers are tied for the individual lead at 147 — Mike Freeman of Central Florida, Ed Bugneaty of Rollins, and Larry O'Toole of Rollins.

Two FSU golfers are tied for fourth with 148s — Greg Fleischer and Tom Krystyn.

Fleischer and Krystyn are followed by teammates Nolan Henke (152), Jon Morrow (159), Rocky Fraleigh (162), and Keith Kulzer (168).

## FSU wins Division I state title

SEBRING — Florida State's men's golf team captured the Division I state championship, but lost the Florida State Golf Championships tournament at Sun and Lakes Country Club Sunday.

FSU and Rollins tied at 904 at the end of regulation. However, Rollins won the playoff and the tournament. Rollins is a Division II school, though, so FSU won the Division I trophy.

Miami finished third (918) among 15 teams, followed by Central Florida (923), Florida Southern (924), and Tampa (934).

Seminole golfers Greg Fleischer and Tom Krystyn tied for the medalist honors with 222. Mike Freeman, from Central Florida, shot a 224 and Nolan Henke from FSU, had a 225.

Other FSU golfers included, Jon Morrow (236), Rocky Fraleigh (241), and Keith Kulzer (256). Krystyn, Fleischer, and Henke made the all-state team by finishing in the top 10.
