

FSU golfers in second

TAMPA — Florida State moved from fourth to second on Saturday, but Florida is atop the Pepsi/Budweiser USF Golf Classic

being played at the University of South Florida.

FSU shot a 285 (3 under par) for a two-day total of 577. Florida had a 284 for a total of 569. Georgia is third at 581 and Florida Southern is fourth with at 582.

Florida State's Keith Kulzer leads the field at 5 under par after firing a 68 in the second for a 139. Florida's David Jackson and Florida Southern's Rocco Mediate are at 140 and FSU's Nolan Henke is fourth with a 141.

Other FSU golfers include: Tom Krystyn (148), Brian Kamm (149), and Greg Fleischer (155).

The final round will be played today.
