South Alabama leads the tournament with a 294, Kent State and Georgia followed at 299 and 302.

Bobby Cochran and Christian Raynor were the Seminoles' top individual performers. They shot 75 each and are tied for 17th place.

Seminole Tony Ziegler tied for 24th with a 76, and Ryan Perna shot 77 for a tie for 31st. Dennis Tymosko was tied at 60th.

TAMPA — The Florida State men's golf team finished in a tie for fifth place with South Florida after the second round of play in the South Florida Invitational.

Dropping from their first-day position of fourth with 303, the Seminoles shot 310 in the second round to finish with a 613.

Georgia leads the field of 18 with a two-round total of 591, shooting 302 and a blistering 289 to edge Kent, which dropped from the top spot to second with a 600 total

Individually, the Seminoles' best two-round score was the 150 shot by Bobby Cochran, who is in 13th place. He edged teammate Christian Raynor by one stroke. Raynor is in 17th place.

Other Seminole finishes include: Ryan Perna, who shot 77-78 for 155, in a tie for 28th; Tony Ziegler, who shot 76-82 for 158, in a tie for 50th; and Dennis Tymosko, who shot 80-81 for 161, in a tie for 61st.

TAMPA — Florida State shot a 303-310-299 for a 912 total and finished tied for fourth with Southern Mississippi at the University of South Florida Invitational this weekend.

Georgia won the tournament by shooting 302-289 and 295 for an 886 — 17 strokes ahead of the closest team, South Alabama, which fin-

ished in second with 903. Kent State finished in third with 905.

FSU's Christian Raynor, in 17th place after two rounds, surpassed Bobby Cochran to place 12th with a 75-76-74 for 225. Cochran shot a 227 to tie for 18th after dropping from 13th after two rounds. Ryan Perna shot a 231 for 31st, Dennis Tymosko 233 for 35th, and Tony Ziegler 235 for 45th.
