LAKELAND — FSU's Bobby Cochran tied for the lead after the first round of action Friday at the Imperial Lakes Golf Classic.

Cochran, a senior from Cordova, Tenn., shot a 68 that tied him with D.J. Holland of South Florida.

FSU is tied with Georgia Southern for eighth place with a first-day total 294. Ohio State leads with a 286. South Florida, Kentucky and Auburn are tied for second at 288 each.

FSU's Christian Raynor is the second highest individual finisher for the Seminoles. He is tied at 25th with a 73.

FSU's Cochran wins ImperialLakes title

LAKELAND — Florida State senior Bobby Cochran picked up his first individual championship Sunday at the Florida Southern ImperialLakes Golf Classic. Cochran shot 68-69-70 to beat out Steve Anderson of Ohio State, who finished second with a 207.

The men's team finished three strokes behind Ohio State. Ohio State shot 286-290-286 for 862 and the championship. The Seminoles shot 294-283-288 for 865.

Senior Christian Raynor had the second highest finish for FSU with a tie for sixth place. Raynor shot 73-71-70 for 214 with Max Anglert of Augusta College.

Keith Rick finished the tournament in a tie for 54th by shooting 78-73-73 for 224, Ryan Perna shot 75-77-75 for 227 and a tie for 72nd, and Dennis Tymosko shot 84-70-82 for 236 and 101st place.
