ROCKY MOUNT, N.C. — David Duval had rounds of 70 and 69 to lead the Atlantic Coast Conference Golf Championships Saturday and help Georgia Tech take a four-stroke lead over Clemson in team standings.

Duval, at 139, was one stroke ahead of Clemson's Nicky Goetz, with Georgia Tech's Mikko Rantanen in a third place tie with Clemson's Mark Swygert at 141.

FSU shot 596 to hold in seventh place.

Jason Williams was tied for 18th place with a 148.

Georgia Tech was at 570 in team standings, with Clemson at 574 on the par-72, 7,122-yard Northgreen Country Club course. Wake Forest was third at 584 while North Carolina State and Virginia were tied at 586 and Duke was at 587.

ROCKY MOUNT, N.C. — The Seminoles finished eighth after shooting 895 in three rounds at the ACC Championships. Georgia Tech won the tournament with an 853 total. Clemson finished at 858 for second place finish.

The Yellow Jackets also won the individual title as well. David Duval shot 70-69-67 for a 206 total.

FSU's individual finishes were: Bobby Cochran (221) tied for 18th; Christian Raynor (222) tied for 20th; Jason Williams (224) tied for 24th; Keith Rick (228) tied for 36th; and Ryan Perna (237) in 44th place.
