MOUNT PLEASANT, S.C. — The Florida State men's golf team heads into the final round of the 26th Annual Palmetto Intercollegiate Golf Classic in ninth-place after firing a 598 for 36 holes Saturday.

The Seminoles are led individually by Ryan Perns, who is tied for 21st place with a 147. Keith Rick checks in tied for 27th with a 149. Tied for 45th place is Jason Williams at 152. Three strokes back in a tie for 60th place is Christian Raynor with a 155 and Bobby Cochran rounds out the field for FSU at 158 for 81st.

Clemson wins Palmetto golf title

Clemson shot a final-round 291 Sunday to win the Palmetto Intercollegiate Golf Classic by eight shots over runner-up Augusta.

The Tigers finished with a three-round total of 867 on the par-72 Charleston National Country Club course in Mt. Pleasant.

Clemson's fellow Atlantic Coast Conference members Florida State and North Carolina finished third and fourth. The host College of Charleston finished fifth while Furman placed 11th.

Clemson's Nicky Goetze finished third in the individual standings. He shot a final-round 70 to finish at 3-under par 213, one shot out of a playoff. Andrew Anderson of East Carolina beat Augusta's Richard Johnson to win medalist honors.

Furman's Scott Summers finished fourth at 214 while Clemson's Danny Ellis was fifth at 216.
