The Florida State men's golf team captured its first victory of the fall season today at the Dixie Intercollegiate in Columbus, GA. The Seminoles fired a final round of sixunder-par 282 to top the eighteen team field.

FSU's two day total of 570 was five strokes ahead of Auburn and first round leader Columbus College. Tennessee and South Florida rounded out the top five.

FSU senior Bobby Cochran took individual honors, shooting 67-71 to win by two shots over South Florida's Chris Colli and Tennessee's Scott Kammann. This marked Cochran's third consecutive top ten finish in as many events.

Florida State junior Christian Raynor also turned in a strong performance, finishing fourth out of the field of ninety golfers with scores of 72-69. Other Seminole contributors were: Denny Tymosko, 76-69, (t15); Ryan Perna, 73-73, (t24); and Keith Rick, 76-76, (t55).

The men's golf team makes its next appearance Nov. 1-2 in Baton Rouge at the LSU Invitational.

Florida State women's tennis player Audra Brannon advanced to the round of eight in the qualifying draw at the Riviera All-American Championships in Pacific Palisades, Ca.

Brannon coasted pass Stacy Jellen of UCLA 6-1, 6-2, in the first round and then defeated Dana Evans 7-5, 6-3 in round two.

Brannon will face Marianne Vallin of UNLV on Wednesday. The winner of the match will advance into the main draw of the tournament on Thursday.
