GIEBLER LEADS FLORIDA STATE AT COCA-COLA TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. – Senior Al Giebler is tied for 39th-place and the Florida State men's golf team is in 13th place in the team standings after the second round of the Coca-Cola Tournament of Champions at the Cherokee Country Club. Giebler was the most consistent Seminole player of the day as he shot a three-over par 73 in round one and a four over par 74 in the second round.

Giebler is in his second year as a member of the Seminole golf team and is playing his second event at the Division I level. He played in one event, the Cleveland Gold/Kiawah Island Invitational, during the fall of 2000. He was a member of Central Alabama Community College's junior college national championship team during the spring 1999 season.

Senior Matt Ackley (Lake Mary, Fla.) shot the best round of the day for the Seminoles, an even-par 70, in round one. He followed his stellar first round score with a 79 in round two and is tied for 54th-place entering round three.

Sophomore Alan Beers (Midlothian, Va.) played well in the second round as he carded a three-over par 73. He is in a tie for 58th-place entering the third round.

The third and final round of the event, a shotgun start, begins at 8:30 Tuesday morning.

SEMINOLE MEN'S GOLF TEAM PLAYS IN THIRD FALL EVENT COCA-COLA TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS CHEROKEE COUNTRY CLUB/KNOXVILLE, TENN./OCT. 22-23, 2001

SETTING THE SCENE

Florida State, coming off its best finish of the fall season, travels to the 2001 Coca-Cola Tournament of Champions at the Cherokee Country Club in Knoxville, Tenn. The event will be played on the Par-72, 6,307-yard Cherokee Country Club Course. Florida State finished 10th in the team standings in this same event last year. Louisiana State is the defending tournament team champion and Alan Morgan of LSU is the defending tournament individual champion.

THE COCA-COLA TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS FIELD

Florida State is joined by Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, the College of Charleston, Georgia State, Louisiana Lafayette, Louisville, Louisiana State, Mississippi State, Tennessee, Toledo, Vanderbilt and Virginia in the 2001 Coca-Cola Tournament of Champions field.

SEMINOLES PLAY WELL AT GARY KOCH/CLEVELAND IN INTERCOLLEGIATE

Junior **Matt Ackley** (Lake Mary, Fla.) shot a career-low tying two-under par 70 in the third round, and the Seminoles finished in ninth place in the team standings at the Gary Koch/Cleveland Golf Intercollegiate last week. Ackley led the Seminoles with a 32nd-place finish in the individual standings. A trio of Florida State golfers followed Ackley – **Brad Lusenhop** (Groversville, N.Y.), **Peter Mitchell** (Miami, Fla.) and **Eric Beaty** (Germantown, Tenn.) – who all finished tied for 42nd-place.

ACKLEY RETURNS TO LINEUP

Junior **Matt Ackley** enjoyed a stellar outing at the Gary Koch Intercollegiate. He was competing in his first tournament since the spring of 2000. Ackley shook off the rust and played well throughout the tournament. His best round of the tournament after posting consecutive scores of 76 in the first two rounds. Ackley's 54-hole total of 222 was the second best of his career. Ackley shot a career-best 219 at the 1999 Billy Hitchcock Intercollegiate. He entered the Gary Koch Intercollegiate averaging 76.66 strokes in 18 previous career rounds and averaged 74.00 strokes in the three rounds last week. His individual finish was his highest since finishing in 27th-place in the 1999 Louisiana State Invitational.

MITCHELL EARNS HIS PLAYING TIME

Junior **Pete Mitchell** shot a career-low 71 in the third round of the Gary Koch Intercollegiate and finished in a tie for 42nd-place in the individual standings with a score of 224. His tournament score of 224 marked the best of his career and his finish in the individual standings was the second best of his career. Mitchell stood in a tie for 64th-place in the individual standings after the first round of play and averaged 72.50 strokes in rounds two and three to improve his placement by 22 positions.

LUSENHOP CONTINUE TO LEAD SEMINOLES

Junior **Brad Lusenhop** played well for the third consecutive tournament and enters the Coca-Cola Tournament of Champions as the Seminoles leading golfer with a 72.89 stroke average in nine rounds. After an uncharacteristic five-over par 77 in the first round of the Gary Koch Intercollegiate, Lusenhop gained 19 spots in the individual standings in round two with an even par score of 72 and was tied for 38th-place after 36 holes. He finished in a tie for 42nd-place in the individual standings. His 72.89 stroke average this fall (in nine rounds) is nearly four strokes lower than his career averaged of 76.89 entering the season. He has carded nearly as many rounds at 75 or below this fall (eight) as he did during his first two years as a Seminole (nine).

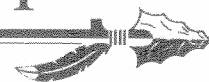

BEATY HITS LOW NOTE AS SEMINOLES FINISH PLAY AT COCA-COLA TOURNAMENT

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. – Freshman Eric Beaty shot a three-over par 73 to lead four Seminole players who all carded 75 or below in Tuesday's final round of the Coca-Cola Tournament of Champions at the Cherokee Country Club. Beaty finished in a tie for 58th-place in the individual standings and the Seminoles finished in 13th-place in the team standings.

Senior Al Giebler (Palm Beach Gardens, Fla.) finished as Florida State's highest-ranking player in the individual standings. He finished in a tie for 48th-place with a three-round total of 222. He shot a three-over par 73 in the first round and closed the competition with a five-over par score of 75.

Beaty (Germantown, Tenn.) played his best round of the tournament and carded his second-best score of the 54-hole event. He shot a 74 in the first round. He is now second on the team with eight rounds of scores below 75 during the 2001 fall season. Brad Lusenhop (Gloversville, N.Y.) shot a five-over par 75 in the third round and finished with a score of 229. He leads the team with ten rounds of scores below 75 this season.

Junior Matt Ackley (Lake Mary, Fla.) continued to play well this season as he finished in a tie for 54th-place in the individual standings. He shot a career-low tying 70 in the first round of the tournament. Ackley finished as the second highest finishing Seminole marking the second consecutive week he has placed among Florida State's top two. He led the Seminoles in the individual standings at last week's Gary Koch/Cleveland Golf Intercollegiate.

Florida State closes out its fall schedule at the Louisiana State Fall Invitational Oct. 29-30.
