FLORIDA STATE MEN'S GOLF TEAM EARNS TICKET TO NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL ROUND WITH STELLAR PERFORMANCE AT NCAA EAST REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

ALPHARETTA, Ga. – The Florida State men's golf team finished in fifth place in the team standings at the NCAA East Regional Championship on the Lakeside Course at the Golf Club of Georgia and earned a spot in the NCAA Championship finals for the first time since 1996. The Seminoles played their best round and counted four under par individual scores to finish with a seven-under par 281 team score in Saturday's third and final round. Florida State will now play in the championship finals for the 18th time in school history and the first time under fourth-year Head Coach Trey Jones. The Seminoles begin play in the NCAA Championship finals May 30-June 2 at Golden Horseshoe Golf Club in Williamsburg, Va.

"The resiliency of our players is main thing I am going to remember about them from this tournament," said Head Coach Trey Jones. "As we look back on how we played this course the previous two times we were here and how we played this week – I can't say enough or commend our players enough for playing so well under pressure."

"I'm not really surprised by how well we played," continued Jones. "I'm also not surprised that we had one of the lowest rounds of the tournament. One of the goals I had as a coach today was to have all of our players shoot par or better in the last round. You have to play this course almost perfectly to have only one guy shoot above par.

Florida State shot 281 as a team with three individual scores of 70 by junior Jonas Blixt, sophomore Matt Savage and freshman Seath Lauer. The Seminoles also counted a 71 by senior Torstein Nevestad toward the team score. The only score not counted in the team score was a two-over par 73 by freshman Cameron Knight. The Seminoles' 281 team score was their fourth best of the season. In addition, the 281 team score put up by the Seminoles in the third round was tied for the top team score of the event along with the 281 total by Georgia in the third round. The Bulldogs, currently ranked as the nation's No. 1 team, won the regional championship by 12 strokes over second place Florida.

"We are ahead of schedule in the maturation of our program," said Jones. "Advancing to the finals was a major goal of our and we knew we had the team to do it this season. Our players just had to compete. They proved that if you want something you have to go out and get it – and they did."

Blixt (Hammaro, Sweden) finished as the Seminoles' top golfer with a one-under par total of 215 – the fifth lowest tournament score of his junior season. He improved his scores on the second and third days of the event. After carding a one-over par 73 in the first round, he totaled an even-par 72 in the second round and finished with a two-under par 70 in the final round. Blixt was one under par with two birdies and one bogie on the front and back nines to earn his team-leading seventh score of the 70 or less this season.

Blixt, an All-ACC selection, finished in a tie for ninth place in the individual standings to earn his career-high seventh top-10 finish of the season.

"I am rally happy that we advanced on as a team," said Blixt. "All of the guys on our team produced this week and showed what we are all capable of. I knew that we could be successful what I first came to Florida State and I knew that we could do it quickly. Our advancing to the finals is a tribute to Coach Jones and his vision for golf at Florida State. I knew when I first spoke with him that there were big things in store for this program and this is just the beginning of many great things to come for Seminole golf."

Savage (Louisville, Ky.) played his best round of golf in the third round as he carded a two-under par 70 and finished in a tie for 24th place with a 220 total for the three round event. He also improved his single round scores throughout the event. After carding a 78 in the first round he finished with an even-par 72 in the second round and an even-par 70 in the final round. Savage closed the event as strong as any player in the field with a five-under par total over his final 12 holes of the round.

Savage, who was also an All-ACC selection in 2007, moved from a tie for 56th place after two rounds into a tie for 24th place in the final standings. He led the Seminoles with 12 birdies during the regional championship.

Lauer (Huntington, Ind.) continued his strong postseason play as he closed the event with a two-under par 70 and a 222 total – the fourth best tournament score of his first collegiate season. He began his stellar third round performance with a birdie and was under par throughout the round. He carded three birdies and was at three-under par at the turn after nine holes and pared eight of his nine holes on the back nine. Lauer played his final 39 holes of the event at one-under par.

Lauer begin the third round in a tie for 71^{st} place and finished in a tie for 40^{th} place in the final standings – an improvement of 31 places in the individual standings. Lauer is averaging 72.00 strokes in his last six rounds played.

Knight (Wesley Chapel, Fla.) played well and finished his play with a one-over par 73 in the third round. He was very consistent over each day of the event as he averaged 74.00 strokes per round and did not finish with a score above 75. Knight was below par for his first 14 holes of the third round and finished at one-over par top earn his best single round score of the event. Knight ranked second on the team with 11 birdies over the 54-hole tournament.

Knight is a total of 15 strokes over par in his last three tournaments and averages 73.67 strokes in his last nine rounds.

Nevestad (Oslo, Norway) tied his season-best single-round score with his one-under par 71 in the final round. He birdied two of his final four holes (including the 18th) to move under par for the round. After a birdie on his second hole of the round, Nevestad reeled off 12 consecutive pars and closed with birdies on 15 and 18 to earn his best single-round score of the event.

Nevestad finished with a six-over par score of 222 – the third consecutive event he has finished at six-over par or better. He is a total of seven-over par and averages 72.78 strokes since returning to the Seminoles' starting line-up for the ACC Championship.

"This is an awesome feeling," said Nevestad. "I have always wanted to play in the national finals and now my teammates have made that possible for me. It doesn't get much better for me than to know that I will play my last round of golf in college in the national tournament.

"I have to give a lot of credit to our freshman – Seath Lauer and Cameron Knight – who played like they were seniors in this tournament," continued Nevestad. "With Jonas and Matt our team is stacked and stacked for the future. You have to play well to make this line-up and I am just happy to have a chance to play with these guys. To be able to go with Coach Jones to the finals is a great feeling. To know how successful Florida State golf is going to be with him as the head coach is something that I will be able to look back on and be very proud of when my golfing days are over."

Led by tournament co-medalist Brendon Todd, the No. 1-ranked Georgia men's golf team won the regional championship. Georgia finished 12 shots ahead of Florida, Auburn and Georgia Tech. Todd shared medalist honors with Billy Horschel of Florida.

DOGS RUN AWAY WITH NCAA EAST REGIONAL

Georgia Tech, Georgia State also advance to NCAA Championship



Alpharetta, Ga. – Four Georgia players shot sub-par rounds Saturday, and the top-ranked Bulldogs posted a 7-under-par team score of 281 on their final round to run away from the field and win the NCAA East Regional golf tournament at The Golf Club of Georgia.

Chris Kirk carded a 3-under-par 69, while Hudson Swafford signed for a 70 to pace Georgia, which won by 12 strokes over Georgia Tech, Florida and Auburn. Brian Harman and Brendon Todd added a pair of 71s on the 7,017-yard Lakeside Course, which yielded its lowest scores of the week in near-perfect weather conditions.

"They played really solid today," said Georgia head coach Chris Haack, whose Bulldogs had never finished higher than second in an NCAA regional tournament. "Our goal, was to come out and try to win it, not just play to get a spot, and they responded. They played awfully well. I just hope we can keep the momentum going to nationals. Everybody's got a little confidence now, so any time you get a little confidence boost, there's nothing wrong with that."

The Bulldogs completed the tournament with a 9-under-par total of 855, while the Yellow Jackets, Gators and Tigers each finished at 3-over-par 867.



Coastal Carolina defeated Clemson for the 10th and final qualifying team in a playoff that lasted four holes and two-and-a-half hours. The Chanticleers began the day in seventh place and fell back after posting a 6-over-par 294, while the Tigers were tied for ninth after 36 holes and shot 292.

Georgia State, which began the day in a tie for 11th, pushed its way into the qualifying group with a 1-under 287. Beginning their round at No. 10, the Panthers made up most of their ground on Nos. 18 and 1, consecutive par-5 holes in which they posted three eagles and three birdies.

The Gators' Billy Horschel tied the Bulldogs' Todd for medalist honors at 6-under-par 210, one shot better than Kirk and Clemson's Kyle Stanley (5-under 211). Patton Kizzire (212) and Glenn Northcutt (213) of Auburn, who each shot 69 in the final round, finished fifth and sixth, while Georgia Tech freshman Chesson Hadley (71) Saturday was seventh at 214.

"The key was staying cool out there and playing level-headed," said Horschel, who won the Golfweek Preview Invitational last fall at the site of the national tournament. "My ball striking was exceptional all week. I was able to keep within myself and not get too upset."

Todd said, "I thought this (setup) was perfect. I really enjoyed how the course played this week. It was great for a regional, where you're looking for people to make a move on the last day. It was still difficult enough to shoot a high score."

Tech's Cameron Tringale, the 36-hole leader at 7-under-par, shot an 80 Saturday, which dropped him back into a tie for 14th and did not count for the Yellow Jackets.
