Seminole Swimmers Beat Georgia Tech 51 to 24

Elorida State University's wellbalanced swimming team claimed its second Southeastern Conference victim in three days here yesterday afternoon. The Seminole mermen led all the way to soundly trounce Georgia 51-24.

Thursday afternoon the Indians defeated University of Georgia's swimmers 46-29 here.

Florida State took first place in six of the nine events and finished 1-2 in four of them to record its third victory of the season against two defeats.

Tech Sets Records

The Tech squad took solace in setting new pool records in the races it did win. John Hiles of Tech, the meet's only double winner, copped the 220-yard free style in 2:21.6 and the 440-yard free style in 5:16 for two of the new marks. Tom Towles of the Yellow Jackets got the other when he swam the 200-yard breast stroke race in 1 minute. 44.5 seconds.

Coach Bim Stults' Florida State team goes on the road next week to face Southern Conference opponents Clemson College at Clemson Friday and University of South Carolina at Columbia, S C Saturday.
