

## 4 Pool Marks Fall as FSU, Georgia Tie

Four new pool records were set here last night as the Florida State University Seminoles and University of Georgia Bulldogs battled to a 42-42 tie in the first swimming meet of the season for both teams.

The flashy Bulldogs, last year's Southeastern Conference champions, took seven firsts in the 10 events, but this individual strength was matched by the Seminoles' depth in each race.

The tie halted a 13-meet victory string by Florida State, the only team to defeat Georgia in 10 dual meets during the 1951 season.

Three of the new pool records were set by Georgia. The crack Bulldog 400 yard free style relay team of Charles Guyer, Charlie Sligh, Reid Patterson and Charles Cooper took the final event on the program to gain the tie for Georgia, setting a new pool mark of 3:40.4 for the distance. Guyer, an All-America performer, coasted to a pool record of 1:40.5 in the individual medley relay race and Patterson took the 200 yard backstroke in 2:40.4, also a new record.

### MINOR UPSET

John Baruch, promising Florida State freshman, scored a minor upset when he defeated Georgia's Charles Cooper and FSU's Dick Wells in the feature race of the night, a 50-yard dash. Baruch was pressed into a pool record of 24.4 seconds as he nipped teammate Wells by a foot.

Other Florida State wins were by Walter Jardine in the 400 yard free style, and by the Seminoles' medley relay team of Scott Ramsey, Wilton Jardine and Mitch Sutherland.
