

# FSU Swim Team Beats Emory, 47-37

ATLANTA. (AP)—The mermen of Florida State University rang up six firsts yesterday as they defeated Emory University's swimming team 47-37.

Emory's Henry Harris, a freshman, set new pool records in the individual medley and 200-yard breaststroke. His victories were the only individual wins scored by Emory, but the Atlanta swimmers took both team relays.
