The Seminoles have now gone undefeated in 17 straight meets since early 1950.

Florida State Coach Bim Stults called on reserves to carry the burden in almost every event as the Seminoles led all the way here There were no double winners as every man on the large Seminole squad saw action.

Florida State wins were chalked up by the 300-yard medley relay team of Jack Burnett, Wilton Jardine and Mitch Sutherland: Ace Richardson in the 220 free style: Walter Jardine, 60-yard free style: 120 yards individual medley, Co-Captain Pete Dunn-Rankin: diving: Larry Beaty: 100 yards free style. Don Van Hise: 200 yards backstroke, Jack Holmes: and 400 yards free style Jack Burney.

Tom Monroe won the 200-yard breaststroke and the Tigers' 400-yard free style relay learn cooped that event for the only Clemson victories of the night.
