## **FSU Second** In State AAU Swim Meet

Miami racked up 91 points as Rosser cracked marks in the 1,500 meter free style, 220-yard free style, and 440-yard free style.

FSU compiled 84 2/3 points for second place. The University of Florida was a poor-third with 46 1/3.

Northwest YMCA of Miami scored 16 points for fourth and the Fort Lauderdale swimming association was fifth with two points.

FSU's only victory was scored by Cooper in the 200-yard backstroke, though Carter of the Seminoles finished in a three-way tie for first place in the 100-yard in backstroke.
