

FSU Second In State AAU Swim Meet

HOLLYWOOD — Florida State University's balanced strength couldn't offset the record-breaking assault of the University of Miami's Galther Rosser, and the Hurricanes splashed their way to the state AAU swimming crown ahead of the runnerup Seminoles yesterday.

Miami racked up 91 points as Rosser cracked marks in the 1500 meter free style, 220-yard free style, and 440-yard free style.

FSU compiled 84 2 3 points for second place. The University of Florida was a poor third with 46 1 3.

Northwest YMCA of Miami scored 16 points for fourth and the Fort Lauderdale swimming association was fifth with two points.

FSU's only victory was scored by Cooper in the 200-yard backstroke, though Carter of the Seminoles finished in a three-way tie for first place in the 100-yard backstroke.
