## Georgia Nips FSU Swimmers

Marshall Floyd, anchor man on the University of Georgia 400-yard free style relay team, mashed nome a nam a nam amead of Florida State University's Dick wens in the final event to give the Bundogs a 40-39 win over Seminole talkmen in a qual swim meet neid last night in the

East Campus pool.

the preceding nine events and had a 39-38 edge going into the linal event, the 400-yard free-style relay. The Tribe set the pace through a little more than half the final event but Georgia's keid Patterson, swimming in the No. 3 position, took the lead for the Bulldogs and his successor Floyd just managed to hold it to provide the Georgia margin of victory.

Patterson, ace Bulldog tanker who has won swimming crowns in SEC, NCAA and NAAU competition, established two new pool records last night. He took first place in the 50-yard free style with the record shattering time of 23.3 secnods, bettering the old mark of 24.4. Patterson swam the 100-yard free style in 52.4 seconds to eclipse the old mark of 53.9 seconds.

Floyd tied the existing mark of 2:06.6 in the 200-yard free style event. The Bulldogs' Hal Stolz won two firsts and a third.
