

C- ATLANTA, Feb. 13 (AP)—North
B Carolina State won the 400-yard
free-style relay tonight to gain a
tie with the University of Florida
in the Southern regional intercol-
legiate invitational swimming meet
at the Georgia Tech pool.

Both teams had 71 points. Flor-
ida State University took third with
47 and Georgia placed fourth with
32. Other teams were Kentucky 18,
Georgia Tech 17, Emory 8, and
Duke 3.

Going into the last event on the
card, Florida mermen held a 61-57
lead over North Carolina State.

The Carolina relay team traveled
the distance in a fast 3:38.1, better-
ing the 3:49 pool standard set by
the University of North Carolina
team in the 1952 meet to win the
event.

The only other pool record to fall
was the 200-yard breaststroke.
Henry Harris of Emory University,
Atlanta, butter-flyed his way the
200 yards in 2:24, knocking five-
tenths of a second off the record
making swim in the morning trials.

Florida's Jim Borland and Ron-
nie Patrick finished one-two in
the diving finals. Other finalists
were Bob Stuke of Florida State,
Larry Deats of FSU, Happy Hill
of Georgia and Bo Kidd of Georgia.
