Florida State's young swimmers started looking toward an undefeated season yesterday after Bim Stults' Seminoles outclassed Northwestern Louisiana State, 54-30, for their sixth straight dual meet victory this season.

Running their two-year victory string to 12, the Seminoles swept eight of 10 first places to coast past the Natchitoches, La., visitors, FSU also won eight firsts in polishing-off-Georgia-Tech, 55-29, in their East Campus pool Friday afternoon.

Dick Rhoton was the individual standout for the two meets. Against Georgia Tech, Rhoton set a new school record in the 200yard breast stroke with a 2:33.5 performance. He broke his own record yesterday against Northwestern, with a 2:32.6 time.

FSU faces its most serious challenge to its undefeated-season ideas Friday. The Seminoles have a return meet with Georgia in Athens. FSU won an earlier match from the Bulldogs, 48-36.
