

Two Florida State University swimmers, senior backstroke ace George Cooper and sophomore handyman Ernie Stock, are competing in the NCAA championships this weekend at Syracuse, N. Y.

Cooper, who bettered his own FSU record in the 200-yard backstroke three times this past season, will enter his specialty, while Stock will vie in the 150-yard individual medley and the breaststroke events.

## Stock Posts Fourth In Swim Meet

SYRACUSE, N. Y., March 27 (AP)—Faced by Ford Konno with two sets of new records and its flashy diving team, the Ohio State Buckeyes tonight won the NCAA team swimming championship for the seventh time.

The Buckeyes piled up 24 team points and nine individual titles.

Ted Robinson, Florida, placed third in the 100-yard breaststroke finals with a time of 1:01.1, and Ernest Stock, Florida State, was fourth in the same event. His time was 1:01.4.
