F S U SWIMMERS EASY WINNERS

Sweeping nine of 10 first places in a surprising display of overall strength, Florida State's swimming team walloped the Georgia Bulldogs, 62-52, here last night.

An overflow East Campus Audience watched Coach Bim Stults' Seminoles rack up their 16th consecutive dual victory in the 1955 season opener for both teams.

MOST LOP-SIDED

It was the most lop-sided triumph for FSU in its sevenyear series with Georgia, no weak sister in Southeastern Conference swim circles. The Seminoles now hold a 7-4-1 lead in

their rivalry with the Bulldogs and have won the last four meets.

The 62 points was the second highest total in State's history. Only once, when the 1950 Seminoles clobbered South Carolina, 64-11, has State rolled up such a one-sided margin.

Stults unveiled a promising array of freshmen that may develop into top-notch college tankmen before long. Yearlings Ken Abbott, Joel Jacobs, John Risher, Don Lewis and Graham Teschke were impressive in scoring points.

BREAKS RECORDS

Two new records were hung up, both by FSU's Ernie Stock. A sophomore from Royal Oak, Mich., Stock received his 1954 All-America swimming certificate from Athletic Director Howard Danford just before the meet, Ernie responded with a new school and pool record in the 150-yard individual medley event, making the distance in 1:35.2. It bettered his own record set last year by more than a second.

Hal Stolz, SEC record-holder in the 200-yard breaststroke, was the only first-place winner for Georgia.

FSU will be idle until Jan. 31, when the Seminoles travel to Texas for dual meets with Southern Methodist and Texas A&M.
