

ATLANTA, Feb. 12 (AP)—Paced by record-breaker Gay Rosser, the University of Miami tonight splashed to victory in the Southern Regional Invitational Intercollegiate Swimming and Diving Championships at Georgia Tech.

The Hurricanes rolled up 78 points to Florida State University's 72. Florida took third place with 45, followed by Georgia with 37, Georgia Tech with 24, Kentucky with 12 and Emory with 11.

Rosser broke two regional records in the competition. He swam the 440-yard freestyle in 4:58.4, breaking his mark of 5:00.6, set yesterday. Another record was snapped when he swam the 220-yard freestyle in 2:15, slicing eight-tenths of a second off Friday's trial time.
