

Florida State's Seminoles presented further proof—at least swimming-wise — that they're ready for Southeastern Conference competition here Wednesday night as they humbled the Georgia Bulldogs, defending SEC champs, 59-25.

In attaining easy victory, the Tribe achieved its 22nd straight dual meet triumph. The last

team to beat the Seminoles was Georgia.

Sharpest thorn in the side of the Seminoles was All-American breastroker and handyman Hal Stolt, captain of the Bulldogs. Stolt was the only athlete to win more than one event Wednesday night. The 5-11 senior captured both the 200 yd. individual medley (2:33) and

the 200 yd. backstroke (2:20.3) events.

Only one Georgia-FSU meet record was broken last night. A FSU combination of John Rhoder, Dick Rhodes, and Ken Abbott began meet competition with a bang, setting a new standard in the 200 yd. medley relay in the time of 3:14.3. It crashed a record of 3:14.3 which had existed since 1930.

Graham Teschke, Jim Julian, Byron Rhodes, Don Lewis, Henry Glancy, and Mike Teschirret all won first places for the Seminoles, while only one other Bulldog besides Stolt, senior Val Arnold, was able to capture a coveted position for Georgia. Arnold and FSU's Lewis finished in a dead heat in the 100 yd. free style.

The last event of the evening was the closest. FSU's Jim Wentworth, Rube Waddell, Teschke, and Lewis edged a Georgia foursome in the 400 yd. free style relay by a stroke.
