Florida State's relentless swimming team pushed its victory string in dual meets to 23 here Saturday night with an easy 60-24 triumph over Emory University.

Four meet records were shattered in the competition, FSU's second of the season. Three standards were set by the Tribe, one by Emory's capable Erik Schonberg, the onl man to win as many as two events.

Schonberg set a record in the 400-yard freestyle with a time of 4:49, while Don Lewis, Glenn Thatcher, and Virgil Waddell set new marks for the Tribe.

Lewis' time of 24.2 was good for the record in the 50-yard dash, Thatcher set his record in the 100-yard freestyle with a time of 55.5 and Waddell established his record with a 2.27.8 time in the 200-yard backstroke.

Howard Fillmor Weibel, and Don Smith grabbed first place for the T in the meet while retra ented freshman Paul Haramon finished a close second Schonberg in two events 200- and 400-yard freety
