

Florida State's swimmers moved successfully closer to their Friday clash with the University of Florida here last night, sweeping Georgia Tech's Yellow Jackets easily aside, 58-28.

The Seminole tankmen led all the way in the dunking of the Yellow Jackets, who Friday bowed to the Gators in Gainesville, 54-30.

It was the Tribe's fourth straight dual triumph over a Southeastern Conference opponent this season and brought the FSU over-all record to 6-1. Other SEC victims this campaign have been Kentucky, Vanderbilt and Georgia, the defending champ.

Sophomore freestyler Don Lewis was the only double winner in the competition, in which four meet records were set.

Lewis captured both the 50- and 100-yard freestyles, shattering the old mark in the former. Standards also fell in the 220-yard freestyle, 200-yard backstroke and 400-yard freestyle relay.

Many inexperienced Seminoles got a chance to display their abilities in the meet, as FSU coach Bim Stults made sure any Gainesville representatives would not see anything they hadn't seen before.
