

Florida State handed the University of Florida swimming team its second worst defeat in history here last night as the Seminoles swam away with a 66-18 victory. The meet opened regularly-scheduled athletic relations between the two schools.

The only other team to whip the Gators worse was North Carolina State, in 1953, when the Wolfpack licked Florida 68-16.

Just before the Seminoles—all 10 of them—went to work, the FSU freshmen roared from behind to down the Gator yearlings 49-28 and give Florida State a clean sweep.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Graham Teschke and Jim Julian scored double victories as the Tribe won nine of the 10 events. Teschke splashed to first places in the 220 and 440-yard freestyle events. Julian chalked up wins in the 50 and 100-yard freestyle matches.

Other Seminole individual winners were Dick Rhoton, 200 individual medley; Ken Abbott, 200 backstroke; and Joel Jacobs, 200 breaststroke. FSU won both the 300-yard medley relay

and the 440-yard freestyle relays. White, Florida AAU diver champion, salvaged one first for Florida by winning the 100-yard freestyle.

NOT EVEN END-BEST

In addition to nine firsts, Coach Don Butler's Seminoles dominated the races by racking up six second places and one third. Outside of White's "blue ribbon" Florida could pick up only four seconds. The Gators finished third in seven events.

The 48-point margin is Florida State's second largest in history, exceeded only by a 68-16

victory over Georgia Tech last year.

No post or school records were set against Florida, but each standard went into the books as a Florida-FSU meet record.

FLASBY START

The Gators put up a stiff fight in the freshman meet, winning the first four events. Florida State came back to oop the last five matches with Virgil Waddell's first place in diving, putting the Seminoles out in front to stay.

FSU also had a 5-4 edge in seconds and won five third places while Florida captured two.
