

Florida State opened its 1957 swimming season by submerging the University of Georgia Bulldogs, 57-29, capturing seven of 10 events.

Georgia's Jim Bankston was the only two time winner of the meet, taking both the 200 and 400-yard freestyle.

Another highlight came in the seventh event when Georgia's Tommy Blakely edged out FSU's Jim Wentworth and Henry Glancy in a close three-way fingertip finish in the 200-yard backstroke.

Team strength in the 400-yard medley relay and 400-yard freestyle relay tipped the scales heavily in FSU's favor as the Seminoles took both events.

Ken Abbott, Joel Jacobs, Mike Tschirret and Jim Julian overpowered the Bulldogs in the 400-yard medley while Pat McKeown, Paul Hammond, Benton Waddell and Ryan Ray did the same in the 400-yard freestyle.

In the diving department Florida State's Byron Rhodes and Jim Justice secured first and third while Georgia's Buddy McNutt took second.

Last night's victory was the Seminoles' fourth in succession over Georgia. Florida State has now won 11 of 13 dual meets with the Bulldog mermen.

The Seminoles meet Emory University Saturday afternoon in the Women's Gymnasium at 2 p.m.
