

ATLANTA, Jan. 19 (AP)—A win in the final 400-yard freestyle relay event gave the Georgia Tech swimming team a 46-40 victory over Florida State University today.

It was Tech's third victory in a row this season and only the fourth loss in four years for FSU.

Tech was trailing 40-39 going into the relay event, but anchor-man Mike Charles overcame a half-stroke lead by FSU's Mike Tschirret on the final lap. The finish was so close two of the five judges ruled the race a dead heat.

Tech's Hal Reeves was the meet's only double winner with firsts in the 200 and 440 yard freestyle.
