PSU swimmers also captured the 400-yard freestyle relay event with a good time of 3:48.9,

The Tribe clinched the most when Joel Jacobs broke his own record in the 200 breaststress with a time of 2:2.9. Jacobs previous mark, set in 1985, was 2:37.4.

A&M sensational Jimmy Okamoto dominated the distance races, taking first place wins in both the 220 and 440 freestyle events:

The Seminoles move on to Dallas Friday for the final meet of their week's tour of Texas, facing Southern Methodist.
