

Florida State's Seminoles came from behind in the final event of yesterday's swimming meet with the University of Florida to win, 46-40.

FSU's 400 yard freestyle relay team of Ryan Ray, Mike Tschirret, Paul Hammond and Jim Julian pulled the plug out of the Gator's 40-39 lead going into the last event as they set a new pool mark to give the Seminoles the victory.

Florida's Phil Drake and Jim Warmington were the meet's only double winners. Drake shattered the old pool mark for the 200-yard butterfly and took first in the 200-breaststroke. Warmington took firsts in both the 230 yard and 440 yard freestyles.

Another pool record fell in the 400-yard medley relay as FSU's Ken Abbot, Tschirret, Joel Jacobs and Julian jumped the Seminoles to a early 7-0 lead.

Florida State's Ray and Julian set meet records in the 50 and 100-yard freestyles while Florida's Bill Ruggle set a new mark in the 200-yard backstroke.

The win gave the Seminoles a 2-1 edge in the swimming series of the two state schools. Last year the two teams split, the Gators winning at home 43-41 and FSU winning here 66-18.
