

Florida State University used its swimming work-horses sparingly here tonight and defeated Rice Institute, 57-29.

The Seminoles won six of the ten events, including both the seven-point relays, to register their second win this year against a single setback. Southern Methodist defeated them last night, 52-34.

The FSU freshmen swimmers defeated the Rice freshmen in a meet intermingled with the varsity encounter, 50-32.

The Seminole varsity swept off to an early lead by dominating the first three events then coasted the rest of the way. Coach Bim Stults sent only one swimmer into each of the last three individual events.

#### RECORDS FALL

Three meet records fell during the encounter with Tom Metz accounting for two of them. The slim freestyler flashed home in the 220-yard freestyle in 2:20.7 and the 400-yard freestyle in 5:17.2.

Ryan Ray of FSU established the third new mark, slipping under the rope in the 50-yard freestyle in a 23.4 time.
