LEXINGTON, Ky. — Florida State's touring swimmers won their third meet in a row here last night by defeating Kentucky, 59-25, and moved on to nearby Louisville for another dual meet tonight.

The Seminoles swept eight of 10 events from the Wildcats and the FSU 400-yard medley relay team breezed up and down the Kentucky pool to set a record of 4:24.6.

Kentucky gained its only firsts in the 50-yard freestyle and in the 440-yard freestyle. Coach Bim Stults juggled his men and for the second straight meet no FSU swimmer was a double winner.

The triumph boosted Florida State's record to four victories against a single setback.

The swimmers dual Louisville tonight and then journey to Fremont, Ohio, where they will swim an exhibition meet tomorrow night. They wrap up the road swing by dualing Oberlin College of Ohio Saturday night.
