OBERLIN, O., Feb. 8—Florida State's swimming team wrapped up a five-day northern tour here this afternoon with a 59-25 victory over Oberlin College.

The Seminole triumph gave them a clean sweep on the tour which included four matches and one exhibition meet at Fremont, O., last night.

FSU's swimmers captured eight of ten first places in the meet. A Seminole exhibition team broke the Ohio Conference 400-yard freestyle relay record. The FSU tankers' time of 3:36.5 was almost six seconds faster than the old mark held by Kenyon College.

Coach Bim Stults' Seminoles will host Georgia Tech in a dual meet Feb. 15. The University of Florida will invade the FSU pool Feb. 22.
