

GAINESVILLE (AP)— Florida State's swimming team trimmed Florida's Southeastern Conference championship team, 52-34 Saturday for the second time this season.

FSU's 400-yard medley relay team of Jerry Glancy, Howard Fillmore, Buck Hiles and Carl Butler established a meet and pool record of 4 minutes 1.1 second. The old meet record was 4:02.3, set by FSU earlier this year at Tallahassee and the old pool record was 4:02.5, set by Florida in 1957.

Hiles also set records in winning the 200-yard butterfly at 2:18.4 and 440-yard freestyle at 4:51.3. His butterfly time bettered his own meet record of 2:19.9 earlier this season. In the freestyle he bettered the pool record of 4:55.8 by Phil Drake of Florida last year.

Glancy set a meet and pool record of 2:14.3 for the 200-yard backstroke. The old pool record was 2:18.6 by Jim Wentworth of record 2:15.0 by Glancy this season.

Fillmore bettered meet and pool records for the 200-yard breaststroke, winning it in 2:33.8. The

old pool record was 2:36 by Joel Jacobs of FSU last year and the meet record was 2:34.8 by Fillmore this year.

Florida's Dave Pollock won the 100-yard freestyle in the meet record time of 52.8 seconds. FSU's Bob Fisher set the old record of 53.7 in 1956 and Bob Duganne of Florida tied it this year.

In a companion meet, the Florida freshmen defeated FSU freshmen 48-38.
