

Florida State's flashy swimming team won eight of 12 events yesterday to capture the first annual Florida Intercollegiate Swimming Championships.

Coach Bim Stults' Seminoles racked up a total of 144 points, well ahead of Florida's 89 total and Miami's 48.

The Gators won three events and the Hurricanes captured first in only one event, the 200-yard butterfly. In that event, Miami's ace Jack Nelson churned the distance in 2:10.3, a new pool record.

FSU sophomore Buck Hiles shattered records in two events. In the 100-yard butterfly he set a pool and school record of :56.8. He also set a pool and school record in the 400-yard freestyle with a 4:21.5 in the morning preliminary.

Florida's outstanding event was the 200-yard freestyle where three Gators copped the first three positions. Dave Calkin won and Dave Pollack and Bob Duganne followed in close order.

FSU's freshman team won both frosh events, the 400 medley relay and the 400 freestyle relay. The time set by the freshman swimmers in the 400 medley relay was under the time set by the varsity swimmers in the same event.

That medley team was composed of Glen Mitchell, Chick Belden, Jerry Braden and Paul Thompson.

It was the final meet of the season for the Seminoles who finished with an 8-1 dual meet record which included two wins over SEC champions Florida.
