

Sweeping nine of 11 first places, Florida State's unbeaten swimmers raced past state-rival Florida, 65-30, before an overflow audience here last night.

It was the sixth straight victory for Bim Stults' hard-working Seminoles and their fourth straight triumph over Florida's Southeastern Conference champs.

FSU, which bested 10 records in the one-sided meet, now owns a 6-2-1 edge over the Gators. Florida has a 4-2 record this season. It was the most decisive FSU victory over the Gators since the first meet (66-18) in 1956.

"All the boys swam well," Stults said happily. "It was a team effort."

Eyeing his fourth perfect sea-

son in 10 years, Stults hit it on the nose. Thirteen Seminoles figured in the scoring with six of them having a hand in the record breaking.

Glenn Mitchell, Roger Simmons, Buck Hiles, and Carl Butler cracked a meet, school, and pool record in the opening event, teaming for a 4:00.9 effort in the 400-yard medley relay.

Hiles, All-America junior from Atlanta, also set a meet record in the 200 individual medley and won the 100 freestyle. Tallahassee sophomore Paul Thompson won two events, setting a school record in the 200 butterfly.

Sophomore Chic Belden swam the 200 breaststroke in 2:31.0 for a school and pool record. FSU's All-America divers, Bob

Weber and Curt Genders, finished 1-2, respectively.

FSU swims next against Miami here Tuesday night.

Florida's freshmen trimmed FSU's frosh, 53½-40½, in the preliminary despite a standout performance by FSU's Risto Pyykko.
