Tex.—Rebounding from its first setback in 18 dual meets, Florida State's slick swimmers smashed four pool records here last night en route to a 58-37 conquest of Texas A&M's Aggies.

It was the second triumph in three starts this season for Bim Stults' Seminoles, who had a 17-meet victory string halted by Southwest Conference kingpin SMU at Dallas Thursday.

Junior Paul Thompson led the FSU assault on the record book in Texas A&M's P. L. Downs Natatorium. The Tallahassee freestyler set new pool records in the 220-yard freestyle (2:10.4) and the 440-yard freestyle (4:45.6).

Buck Hiles, senior All-America from Atlanta, turned in his fourth record in two nights on the Texas tour by negotiating the 133-yard individual medley in 1:25.5. The unusual distance for that event was established because of the 33½-yard A&M pool length. Hiles also won the 100-yard freestyle event.

Risto Pyykko, talented Brooklyn, N. Y., sophomore, added a fourth pool record by churning the 100-yard butterfly in 58.3 seconds.

Other winners for the Seminoles were All-America Curt Genders in diving and Bill Richardson in the 200-yard breaststroke. FSU's 400-yard medley relay team was a winner to give the Seminoles eight out of a possible 11 first places.

It was FSU's seventh triumph in eight dual starts against the Aggies.

The Seminoles left Texas early today for the return trip to Florida. They entertain Alabama's Crimson Tide at Tallahassee next Thursday night.
