

FSU won eight of the 11 events, setting meet records in the first four races. Hiles, who has broken more records than any Seminole swimmer in history, set pool and school records with a 2:06.4 effort in the 220-yard freestyle.

Hiles edged junior teammate Paul Thompson, who established the FSU pool and school records of 2:07.3 earlier this season, by an arm-length in a crowd-pleasing finish. Hiles now holds four school records and shares in a fifth record.

Genders, the Sarasota product who will be bidding for his third straight All-America diving role in national competition later this

month, easily won his specialty. In three years, Genders has never lost to a Seminole opponent in dual meets.

Briley made his last hometown showing as a Seminole a good one, winning the 440-yard freestyle. Butler played a fine hand in a weird, laugh-provoking—and losing—FSU entry in the closing 400-yard freestyle relay.

### SENIORS SALUTED

Stults saluted the seniors by pairing them in the freestyle relay, with diver Genders swimming the second leg of 50 yards. In an unnatural element, Genders gave it the best he could. So did Butler, Briley and Hiles. But East Carolina won the race.
