OXFORD, O. — Florida State's Lee Branford made a record-smashing performance to lead the Seminoles' swim team past Miami of Ohio, 65-30, here last night.

It was the third straight triumph for the Tribe tankmen. They tangle with Bowling Green there tomorrow night.

Branford won the 50 and 100 freestyles, set meet and school records in each. He was timed in 22.9 in the 50, 50.1 in the 100.

FSU's Dale Smith finished second to Branford in both events.

In all, eight meet records were set out of the 11 events.

The Seminoles' Paul Thompson of Tallahassee set a new meet record in the 220 freestyle, 2:08.9. Risto Pyykko's 2:18.3 time in the 200 butterfly was another meet record.

Dick Acosta was first in the 200 backstroke with 2:18.2 time. Pete Davis finished second.

Bill Dahl set a new meet record in the 400 freestyle a 5:58.5 time.

Tommy Mew and Pyykko finished first and second in the 200 individual medley. Mew's time was 2:20.5.

Mark Owen won the diving event. Tom Lacosta was second in the 200 breaststroke.

Acosta, Bill Lawrence, Pyykko and Davis teamed to win the 400 medley relay in the meet record time of 4:01.0.
