

BOWLING GREEN, O.—Risto Pyykko turned in a double-winning effort and sparked Florida State's swim team to a 71-24 victory over Bowling Green of Ohio.

It was the fifth straight triumph for the Seminoles, second straight on their current road tour. They take on the University of the South at Sewanee, Tenn., tomorrow night.

Pyykko was first in the 200 individual medley with a time of 2:19.3 and first in the 200 butterfly with a time of 2:19.1.

Tallahassee's Paul Thompson was first in the 220 freestyle with a time of 2:07.8, a new record. Thompson was also third in the 100 freestyle.

Bill Dahl was second to Thompson in the freestyle. Peter Combes was second in the 200 butterfly and Tommy Mew was second in the 200 individual medley.

Setting a new pool and meet record in the 100 freestyle was Lee Bransford with a time of 58.3. He also finished second in the 50 freestyle and Dale Smith third in the same event.

Dahl grabbed a first in the 400 freestyle with a time of 5:04.4. Dick Acosta set a new meet record in the 200 backstroke with a time of 2:14.3.

In the 200 breaststroke Tom Lacenta finished first with a 2:32.9. Bill Richardson was in second place.

The 400 medley relay team of Acosta, Bill Lawrence, Combes and Bransford won in 3:55.1, a new meet and school mark.
