

Florida State opened its swimming season here last night by defeating the University of Georgia 66-29.

The Seminoles had to come from behind after being disqualified in the first event. FSU then went on to win eight of the 11 events.

Dale Smith of the Seminoles was the only swimmer to win two events. He won the 50-yard freestyle and the 100-yard freestyle.

FSU's Doug Kruger set a pool and meet record in the 200-yard breaststroke. He covered the distance in 2:19.7.

The University of Georgia standout was Alex Patterson, who swam in all three events that the Bulldogs won.

The FSU freshmen defeated the Georgia freshmen 72-23 in a preliminary meet.

Tut Heisler, former Leon High athlete, set a school freshmen record with a time of 2:14.6 in the 200-yard individual medley. Old record of 2:16.2 was posted by Risto Pyykko in 1960.
