

ATLANTA — Grabbing first places in seven of 11 events, Florida State swimmers raced past Georgia Tech 63-31 Thursday.

The Tribe tankers broke six pool records as they ran their record to 5-2. The 400-yard medley team composed of Jim Mullally, Doug Kruger, Risto Pyykko and Bruce Quayle set one with a time of 3:30.9.

While participating in that event, Mullally broke another record in the 100-yard backstroke, finishing with a 1:00.3.

Pete Combes set a new mark by finishing with a 2:12.2 in the 200-yard butterfly. Pete Davis set one in the 200-yard backstroke with a 2:13.8.

The 400-yard freestyle relay team garnered the fifth one, posting a 3:33.0. Bob Durecher, Quayle, Dale Smith and Charles Tandy swam on the team.

Mark Cohen posted a 2:14.5 to set a record in the 200-yard individual medley.
